

HURRICANE FOOTBALL MONTH IN REVIEW

8/22 JAMBOREE VS. HC-EVERGREEN AND GULF SHORES

The Hurricanes went back to basics Friday night. Bryant used a punishing rushing attack to defeat Gulf Shores 13-6 in as part of a four team Jamboree. The Canes also tied Hillcrest-Evergreen 6-6. Eddie Jones scored two touchdowns to lead the Hurricane scoring assault. Jones carried the ball 20 times for 151 yards. Lim Windham added ten carries for 46 yards and a score. Jesse Goodwin carried eight times for 44 yards. The Hurricane defense did not allow positive rushing yards in both games combined. George Wilkinson led the Cane defense with three sacks. Deangelo Rogers also had a sack. Logan Paul led the Gulf Shores offense with 147 yards passing, completing eight of nine attempts.

9/6 VS. WILLIAMSON

After taking an early 7-0 lead, the Hurricanes faded late, falling to the Williamson Lions 24-14. Bryant took the lead on D.D. Smith's school record 95 yard interception return. Williamson took control for good in the third quarter. Quarterback Myron King threw the first of his two touchdown passes to Mujahid Assad, giving the Lions a 16-7 lead. King was 11 of 17 for 164 yards on the night. Assad had three catches for 75 yards. Williamson running back Quinton Marshall added 19 carries for 139 yards and a touchdown. The Hurricane offense was lead by Eddie Jones who rushed for 63 yards. Lim Windham added 49 yards of total offense and a touchdown. Donald Malone lead the Hurricane defense with 3 sacks. Larry Lumpkin added nine tackles, while Josh Flowers and George Wilkinson added eight and seven tackles respectively.

9/12 VS. BLOUNT

Despite out gaining the Blount Leopards 279 yards to 162, The Hurricanes fell Friday night 30-21. Three costly special teams miscues hurt the Canes throughout the game. In the first quarter, following a Bryant touchdown, Jared Robinson took the ensuing kickoff 74 yards to set up a 15 yard Leopard scoring drive. Early in the third quarter a bad snap over punter Brandon Creal's head would lead to an eight yard Blount TD. The backbreaker for the Hurricanes came on the first play of the fourth quarter, when Ray Wrightington took a Creal punt 55 yards for the game sealing touchdown. The special teams gaffes overshadowed a great night for the Bryant offense. Jesse Goodwin rushed for 102 yards and three touchdowns, while Eddie Jones also had 102 yards rushing. Ricky LaForce completed five of eight passes for 75 yards. Lim Windham added 59 all-purpose yards. Larry Lumpkin led the Cane defense with 11 tackles. Josh Flowers added 6 tackles. D.D. Smith had an interception for the second consecutive week..
