



STREAKING CANES BEAT MGM

The Alma Bryant Hurricanes defeated the Mary G. Montgomery Vikings on Friday night 20-10. The victory is the second consecutive for the Canes, improving their record to 2-4 overall and 1-3 in region play. This also marks the first time the Canes have won back-to-back games since 2003. The Hurricanes fell behind early, trailing 10-6 in the second half, before charging late. A Ricky LaForce 16 yard touchdown pass to Lim Windham, with just over two minutes to play in the fourth quarter, sealed the deal for the Canes. Eddie Jones led Bryant on the ground with 81 yards, including a 67 yard touchdown run in the first quarter. Stephen Boler added 44 yards on six carries. Larry Lumpkin and Josh Flowers each had five tackles to lead the Hurricane defense. Donald Malone and Harry Edwards each had a sack. Bryant will return to "The Eye" for the final time in the regular season this week, playing host to the Baker Hornets. It will be senior night for the class of 2009.
