No Intentional Walks for Intramurals

Clinic 7 Special Rule for Outs - Player leaves base when out. Changed from 3 outs clears bases.

Courtesy Runner for Catcher with 2 outs - allowed. Player who made last out at bat. All leagues.

Pitching Week is Sunday - Saturday

Pitcher Must be removed after hitting 3 batters in same game. (For Rookies/Minors 9/Minors 10 - must be removed if hit 2 in one inning)

If Borrowing a player from other team - it must be the perspn hitting when last out recorded. Change to last batted out?

SAFETY - Cup must be worn by all Pitchers and Catchers. STRONGLY recommended for all players.

5 run rule means: - No more than 5 runs scored per half inning except in last inning of play. Play continues until ball is dead, though only five runs count.

- In last inning of play (either sixth inning or last inning as determined by umpire and coaches, unlimited runs may be scored.

Steals follow Cal Ripken/Babe Ruth rules. In single A league, steal is announced by stealing team, batter steps out of box. Runner can leave base when catcher receives ball.

NOTE 1: Teeners - 10 batter rule - the runners will only be able to advance in the manner they would under normal circumstances, not to continue running. In last inning, runs scored is unlimited.

NOTE 2: After 4 balls, batter retains strikes and coach pitches until ball in play or strike out.

Note 3: Player is permitted to continue to pitch to a batter if the pitch count is exceeded while facing a batter, count above no balls, no strikes.

NOTE 4: The following rest requirements are mandatory:

- If a player pitches 61 or more pitches in a day, three (3) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 41 60 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 1 40 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- A player may not play catcher after pitching in a game.

Note 5: Starts 3rd week of season.
