We strive to keep costs low and believe that we are the best value in AAU Girls Basketball in the Greater Richmond Area.

Fees

The fee for playing on the 7th grade team:

\$250.00 per season

The fee for playing on the 9th grade team:

\$300.00 per season

What your fee includes:

- Coaching
- Practice Time
- Team and player registration with the Amateur Athletic Union (AAU)
- The uniform (the uniform remains the property of the Chesterfield ACES)
- Registration for the team for all planned tournaments
- Individual Attention
- Leadership skills
- Friendships that will last a life time

ADDITIONAL COSTS

They include:

- Hotel and transportation costs
- Meals while traveling
- Entrance fees to tournament events for parent spectators
- Shooting t-shirt and Aces travel bag
- Quality basketball shoes
- Fundraising
- There may be other costs that arise

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Can I talk to the coach about playing time?

The coaches strive to give every girl a chance to play while maintaining a competitive team. You can ask your daughter's coach about what she can do to increase her playing time, but playing time is the coaches' decision only. The best way to get more playing time is to practice more in your own driveway!

- Can we play on another AAU or travel girls basketball team and play on the ACES?

No, this would cause conflicts at tournaments where both teams are registered. You can play recreation league as long as you let your coach know your schedule.

- Can my daughter play another travel sport and play with the ACES?

Yes! We ask that you let your coach know when conflicts arise between both sports. We ask that you make basketball a priority for very important events like state and national tournaments.

- Are the Chesterfield ACES insured and do they complete background checks on coaches?

The Chesterfield ACES are insured for general liability through the AAU. The AAU also completes background checks on all coaches and bench personnel. Basketball is a high risk sport and injuries do occur while playing. Please be aware that injuries will be covered by your own health insurance.

- How long is the ACES season, how many tournaments do you play, and how often do you practice?

Our season runs from the end of the school girls basketball season to the middle of July. We play 1 to 2 tournaments a month. We practice 2 to 3 nights per week.

- How far do you travel?

Most tournaments that we play are in Virginia. We occasionally travel out of state with preplanning and parent input.

- How many overnight hotel stays will there be?

We plan for hotel stays approximately 2 to 4 times or 4 to 6 nights per season. We negotiate with hotels to acquire reasonable nightly rates.
