

Our cover depicts **AI Kinley**, a man who, we believe, requires no introduction to members of the Giants family. Many of us believe that without AI, there would be no Giants organization as we know it today. His impending induction into the Manitoba Baseball Hall of Fame (MBHOF) as a **Builder** provides a unique opportunity to recognize his part in making the Giants organization what it is today.

A <u>VERY</u> short list of some of his accomplishments and contributions includes:

- Coach and manager of multiple minor-league teams that fed the reborn Giants organization in the late '70's
- Director of the Red River Valley Sports League that developed and continues to develop many of the players that have success as Giants
- One of a small group who restarted the Giants organization in 1977
- Has held many official titles with the Giants and has contributed untold hours to promote Club viability and the teams' successes
- Helped grow the Giants organization to include three successful teams
- Recruited numerous coaches and managers who have led Elmwoodbased teams at many levels to city and provincial championships
- Coached and / or managed many Provincial Championship teams, several of which also represented Manitoba regionally and nationally
- Multiple titles as "MJBL Manager of the Year"
- Member of the Baseball Manitoba Honour Society (2003)
- Member of the MBHOF as a Coach (2006)
- Baseball Manitoba Volunteer of the Year (2007)
- Currently the Baseball Manitoba representative to the MBHOF
- Giants "historian extraordinaire" who has led the efforts to collect and collate the Club's significant archives
- Contributed to and led several successful nominations for Giants family members to be inducted into the MBHOF

A successful athlete in his own right in many sports, Al was a starting lineman on the 1969 and 1970 Vanier Cup-winning University of Manitoba teams and was a three-time Conference All-Star. His teaching career in Physical Education included duties as an administrator of various scholastic athletic programs.

As well, he has been a participant and leader in other sports (e.g., football, hockey, gymnastics, volleyball, lacrosse, etc.) and in other leagues (e.g., high school, university, etc.), coaching or managing teams to provincial and national championships in those disciplines as well.

We invite everyone to make plans to help the Club celebrate Al in Morden on June 5, 2010.



#### Cash Calendars 2009: The results

The sale of the Cash Calendars is the single most important fund-raiser for the Elmwood Giants Baseball Club again this year. Without the monies raised through this year's sales, the Club would not be able to undertake some of the important upgrades described elsewhere in this newsletter.

This year, we sold 2000 Cash Calendars with a net profit after expenses of more than \$15,000. While substantial, this result put us below our sales last year of 2300 tickets and well below our goal of 2500. Our profit, although below our desired goal, will go a long way toward ensuring the continued viability of our Club . **Thank you** to all who contributed to this success!

We encountered a variety of reasons for the low sales, but two of the most telling were the fact that more than 400 unsold tickets were not returned, despite the fact the Club provided a postage-paid pre-addressed return envelope and some of our former top sellers sold fewer tickets.

On a positive note, the alumni sold over 600 and the Board of Directors alone sold over 400. **Don Krasowski** sold 117 tickets while **Reg Chopp** and **Ray Shuel** sold 70 each. The <u>Corvette Club</u> and the <u>Dragon Boat</u> team both sold well for us.

Other work will be required to prepare the field for play in the **2010 season**. The field is key to providing a high quality baseball experience and maintaining it is a big job! The Club has reviewed the information returned to it by **Bev Fisher** about the costs for <u>putting up the scoreboard</u>. This will be a major upgrade to the field, made possible by many people over the past few years with their contributions to Giants fund-raising efforts. # Lessons from the Past: The Role of Fund-raising

Back in the 40's and 50's, men like **Alex Turk** and **Curly Haas** sponsored the Giants. After their sponsorship was gone in 1962, the Club folded. Despite the fact there was an abundance of players available, a thriving feeder system and a suitable playing field (Giants Field!), operations ceased; partly because there was no organization to raise the necessary operating funds that would make the experience affordable for the players and their parents. This is similar to the more recent experience in the North End, where the team sponsored by the 141 Legion ceased operations when the Branch withdrew its financial support in the mid-nineties.

Several attempts were made by various groups in the late sixties & early seventies to restart the Giants, but nothing lasted. Not until 1977 did a viable group come together to re-establish and operate the Giants. The goal was to put an organization in place that would ensure the longevity of the program.

During the 1970's and 1980's, men like **Joe Sandryk, Ted Nowicki, Ross Kinley, Al Kinley, Dave Olsen** and many others raised thousands of dollars to get the Club where it is today. Few people from the original group are still active but enough people have come on board over the years to allow the Giants to continue to operate.

Do you remember the Grey Cup pools, the socials, the meat draws, Bingos, umbrella sales, Jets and Bombers season ticket raffles, Spectator seats, etc? The off-field people worked hard so that the on-field player could have an enjoyable experience at a reasonable cost and so the Giants program would survive and thrive. Things are no different today. There are just different ideas and different people.

There is no doubt different financial circumstances dictate what each of us is able to do and some of us have no market to sell tickets. Some just buy their assigned tickets and to these people we say a special thank you. Even the purchase of one ticket at \$10 is appreciated! We know it is a way of saying: "Thanks Giants! And I wish I could do more!" To the active volunteers, it is disappointing to see the number of alumni who can simply write off the Giants, despite the benefits they received from their participation in the program.

To the <u>current players</u>: The off-field events are how we are able to keep the fees so low. Without more participation from the players, our only option will be to raise the fees for those who don't contribute.

In addition to positions on the Executive, there are opportunities for people to contribute in many other ways. If you can help or if you have any ideas on how to make the Giants a better organization and to help it avoid disappearing again, please contact a Director or attend the upcoming <a href="Annual General Meeting">Annual General Meeting</a>; planned meeting date, time and location are found elsewhere in this newsletter.
