## Rules and Regulations

1) Coin flip will determine home team and dugout for each game. Home team gets choice of dugout. Forest Grove will be home team for all games they play and occupy the home dugout (third base at high school or Pacific).
2) Each game will have a $21 / 2$ hour time limit. No new inning will start after $21 / 2$ hours. This includes the final game of each day.
3) If two teams tie after the time limit the game will be recorded as a tie in the standings. There will be no reverting back to break the tie.
4) High School rules will be played with metal bats.
5) Courtesy runners may be used for pitcher and/or catcher at any time but must be used with two outs. Please have the courtesy runner ready. Courtesy runner should be any player who is not currently in the game.
6) Ten-run rule will be used for all games after five innings.
7) Infield will be taken before the first game of each day and time pending for all later games.
8) After round-robin play, ties in the standings will be broken according to:
a. Runs Allowed
b. Coin Flip
c. In the case of a three way tie, most runs allowed will remove the lowest team and then the rules above will break the tie between the two remaining teams.
9) Please help out on your side with your extra players on foul balls.
10) Please clean dugout after your game.
